WKS	TOPICS	CONTENT/ACTIVITIES	LEARNING MATERIALS
1	GENDER Issues in Child Care: Play	i. Give simple meaning of play. ii. Discuss the meaning of gender. iii. Guide pupils to identify self as male or female. Note: Assign duties equally to grouped children irrespective of sex.	Gender sensitive - Story books. - Poetry books - Musical Instruments - Toys - Plates - Radio - Television - Video
2	Gender Issues in Child Care: Games	i. Discuss functions of games in our society. ii. List and discuss some local game in our community e.g. suwe, tenten, etc. Note: Engage pupils in different games irrespective of sex.	- Building blocks - Audio visual - TV/DVD - Flash cards - Real objects in the class
3	Sharing	i. Discuss simple meaning of sharing. ii. Mention and discuss some items that can be shared among pupils e.g. cake, biscuits, sweets, seat, umbrella etc.	- Pictures of various objects - Charts.
4	Songs	i. Discuss the meaning of song.	



		ii. Organise singing activities for children irrespective of sex.	
5	Folk tales	i. Tell stories that will make pupils to appreciate one another irrespective of their genders ii. Encourage few pupils to tell their stories too.

7	NATURAL SHAPES	i. Expose the pupils to different shapes in the environment e.g. full moon – Circle, lips – oval, nose – triangle, finger – cylinder etc. ii. Group pupils for team work skills in identifying the values of natural shapes in our environment.	
8	Natural Colours	i. Help pupils to identify some natural colours in the environment e.g. wool – white, rose/hibiscus flower – red, leaf – green, sky – blue, egg yolk/ripe mango – yellow etc. ii. Group pupils to identify natural colours and their values in the environment.	
9	Responsibility	i. Give simple meaning of	



		responsibility. ii. Guide the pupils to identify simple responsibilities e.g. do not litter class, street, road, gutter or places of worship, punctuality - getting to functions early, playing safely etc.

1	REVISION	Revision of 1 st Term's work	Charts showing a child that is sweeping, washing etc.
2	Punctuality	i. Give simple meaning of punctuality. ii. Recite the poem 'Early to bed' to the pupils. iii. Mention and discuss some places/occasions that pupils should be punctual e.g. school, places of worship, naming ceremony, wedding etc.	
3	Responsibilities: Home	i. Mention some responsibilities that children can perform at home e.g., sweeping, dusting, washing etc. ii. List some materials for cleaning e.g. broom, brush, napkin etc. iii. Encourage pupils to give service to others at home.	
4	Responsibilities: School	i. Mention some services pupils can give at school e.g. class arrangement, returning lost items, caring for junior pupils in the school etc. ii. Engage children in role play	



		on how to keep the class and school environment neat and tidy	A Charts on a school, Mosque Church
5	Responsibilities: Religious Places	Guide pupils to take care of personal and communal belongings at the places of worship.

8	Obedience	i. Give simple meaning of obedience. ii. Mention and discuss some actions of obedience e.g. doing home work, leaving playground after lunch break, obeying traffic rules etc. iii. Tell stories to pupils on obedience.	
9	Self Control	i. Discuss simple meaning of self control. ii. Discuss some actions to show self control among pupils e.g. to keep away from - fighting, telling lies, stealing etc. iii. Discuss the rewards of self control.

2	Orderliness: Home	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Discuss simple meaning of orderliness. ii. Discuss with pupils how to maintain orderliness at home e.g. bathroom, toilet, kitchen etc. 	
3	Orderliness: Neatness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Give simple meaning of neatness. ii. Expose and discuss the importance of neatness in the house. iii. Expose pupils to posters/ charts showing neatness at home. 	
4	Orderliness: School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Discuss with pupils the meaning of orderliness at schools. ii. Mention some places where laws and orders should be maintained. e.g. in the school assembly, playground, corridors, stairways, grocery, books store, library etc. 	
5	Orderliness: Community	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Discuss with pupils the meaning of orderliness in the 	



		community. ii. Mention and discuss some places where laws and orders should be maintained in the community e.g. bank, local market, supermarket, queue at bus stop, school, clinic/hospital etc.

7	Orderliness: Community	i. Train pupils how to take turns in a queue. ii. Train pupils how to maintain peace and order in public places with the use of posters/charts, drama, songs, rhymes.
8	Cooperation: Home	i. Discuss simple meaning of cooperation between children and their parents. ii. Give examples of cooperation among pupils, between pupil and parents on food, schooling, health/ cleanliness etc.
9	Cooperation: Schools	i. Discuss simple meaning of cooperation between the pupils and the school authority. ii. Give examples of cooperation among the pupils, pupils and teachers e.g. class work, team work, project, debate, quiz etc.

WKS	TOPICS	CONTENTS/ACTIVITIES	LEARNING MATERIALS
1	FIRST Aid: First Aid Box	i. Discuss the meaning of first aid. ii. Mention some first aid box/kit contents to the pupils e.g. bandage, wool, scissors, plaster etc.	- Well Stocked first aid box/kit - Charts posters showing first aid application - Water
2	First Aid: Uses	i. Discuss the uses of the content of the first aid to pupils. ii. Demonstrate the use of the items to pupils.	- Soap - Cotton Wool - Bandage - Plasters.
3	My Body: Parts	i. Teacher sings song and recite rhyme on parts of the body. ii. Mention some parts of the body to pupils e.g. head, ears, nose, eyes, arms etc. iii. Explain to pupils why we care for our body.	- Iodine - Scissors - Disinfectant splints - Pictures - Posters - Charts.
4	Body Care for cuts	i. Give simple meaning of cuts to pupils. ii. Guide pupils on first aid treatment to cuts on the body, that is, stop the blood, wash,	



		clean and cover.
5	Body Care for wounds	i. Give simple meaning of wounds to pupils. ii. Guide pupils on first aid treatment on wounds in the body e.g. rest head on soft pillow, raise the wounded leg/ arm and stop the blood with a piece of cloth.

7	Body Care on Sickness	i. Explain simple meaning of sickness. ii. Give example of sickness e.g. fever. iii. Discuss the steps to take for recovery. That is, visit the doctor, eat and drink, take medication, sleep.
8	Food	i. Give simple meaning of food. ii. Mention types of food we have in our environment e.g. rice, beans, yam etc. iii. Discuss the use of food in our body e.g. to make us grow, to give us energy etc. caution pupils not to expose/ uncover their food to flies and ants to avoid food poisoning.
9	Garden Tools	i. Give simple meaning of garden tools.



		ii. List and discuss some garden tools we have in our environment e.g. rake, cutlass, hoe, shovel, wheelbarrow etc.
